Joint UCL-UC Chile PhD Application Process

In order to be eligible to apply to the Joint UCL-UC Chile PhD track, you must first have applied to the UC Chile Doctorate in Engineering Sciences (Doctorado en Ciencias de la Ingeniería) and have been accepted in the program. Please note that the full application must be submitted in English, including the recommendation letters. For more information, please visit this link.

Once you have been accepted in the UC Chile program, you must fulfil the following additional Entry Requirements to apply to the Joint UCL-UC Chile PhD track:

- A master's level degree from a UK or a Chilean university in a subject appropriate to the chosen field is required to apply to this program, or an overseas qualification of an equivalent standard as determined in line with the applicable UCL policy.
- English language requirements: an IELTS Overall grade of 6.5 with a minimum of 6.0 in each of
 the subtests or equivalent as determined in line with the applicable UCL policy, is required to

- Further documentation that the program's Joint Management Committee may need to assess your application, such as Primary university supervisor (primary supervisor), Secondary university supervisor (secondary or subsidiary supervisor), Working title of thesis, etc. The program administration will contact you with the details.
